Aims

Morecambe Sailing Club's aim is to promote water sports in the local area. The club's committee recognise the importance of training for the safe and competent use of boats. It is our intention, therefore, to provide training, to RYA standards. The committee bestow responsibilities to the following people.

Responsible Officers

- The Principal, John Gibbison will have overall responsibility for safety.
- The Chief Instructor – Dinghy, Keith Byers
- The Chief Instructor – Powerboat, John Hodgson
- The Chief Instructors will be responsible for the maintenance of all club owned dinghies, powerboats and trailers, assisted by other members where necessary.

Note!

All club members, students & instructors have a responsibility to co-operate with the above people to achieve a safe teaching environment.

Risk Assessment

A risk assessment has been carried out, highlighting the potential hazards and listing the precautions that must be observed to minimise the risks.

The risk assessment will be reviewed on an annual basis, or sooner if there are any significant changes that could cause a new hazard.
