Spread of Covid-19 Coronavirus	<p>Club members, volunteers, sailors and visitors</p> <p>Vulnerable groups, elderly, pregnant members, anyone with underlying health conditions</p> <p>Anyone else who physically comes in contact with other people in relation to our activities</p>	<p><u>Hand Washing</u></p> <p>Hand washing facilities with soap and water in place</p> <p>Stringent hand washing taking place</p> <p>Gel sanitisers in areas where washing facilities are not readily available</p> <p><u>Cleaning</u></p> <p>Frequent cleaning and disinfecting of objects and surfaces that are touched regularly such as door handles and light switches in areas such as the Clubhouse entrance hall and toilets, Race Hut, Boat Compound and Boat Shed</p>	<p>Members are reminded on a regular basis to wash their hands for 20 seconds with soap and water and dry with paper towels. Dispose of latter in bins provided. Catch coughs and sneezes in tissues (available throughout the premises).</p> <p>In general, follow the COVID-19 public health advice.</p> <p><u>Cleaning Shared Equipment</u></p> <p>Any shared equipment should be wiped down with water/detergent/disinfectant before and after use. This will include boats, buoyancy aids, trolley handles and any other shared objects/materials</p>
